The dominant collegiate lettering articulates a focus on education and student leadership. The swooping arrow arch is a common motif in today's designs and definitely embodies an active organization that moves toward new arenas. The color of the emblem is one of the organizational colors—red.

With its space-like feel, this emblem is sure to last well into the future, but will always be linked to the time when FHA at the turn of the century changed to FCCLA.
