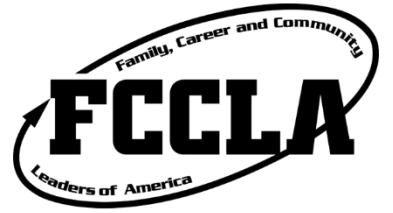

Be the most involved in FCCLA as possible (attending district meetings, networking with members, and so much more)

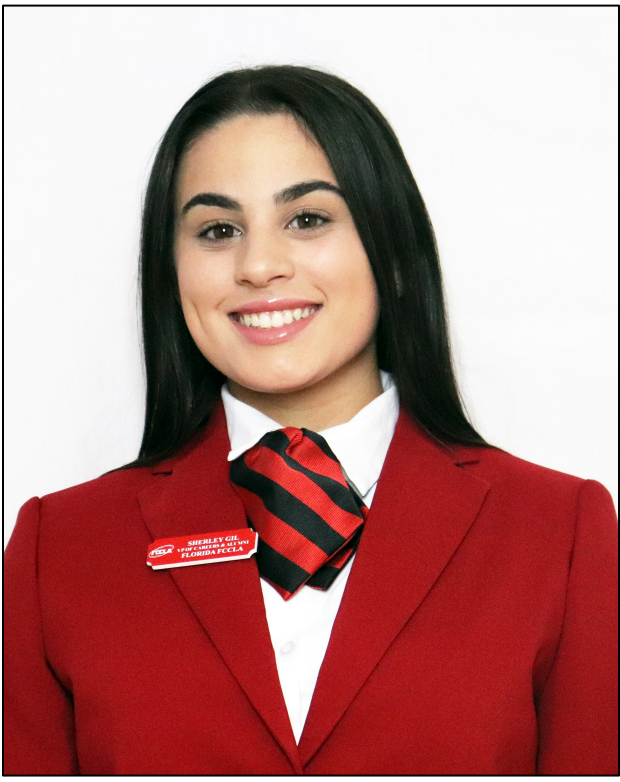
WHAT ARE YOUR FUTURE PLANS?
