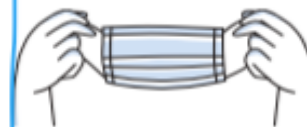

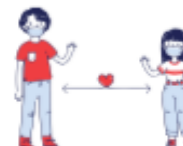


Meet Kaytlynn Feliz
