#### **BACHELOR DEGREE SCHOLARSHIP | \$1500**

#### ASSOCIATE DEGREE SCHOLARSHIP | \$1000

A \$1000 scholarship to an outstanding FCCLA senior planning to enroll in a vocational/technical school, community college, or junior college in a Family and Consumer Science related occupation.

#### **LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT SCHOLARSHIP | VARIES**
