

Changes to Florida Proficiency Events

The following is a listing of the changes in the 2026-2027 Florida Proficiency Event Manual. It is in no way inclusive and participants and advisers should continue to **read the event rules carefully** to ensure eligibility and successful event completion and presentation.

Artistic Reflections participants will now be awarded ribbons instead of medals. Project scoring 90-100 will receive a blue ribbon. Projects scoring 70-89.99 will receive a red ribbon. Projects scoring 50-69.99 will receive a white ribbon.

Culinary uniforms for junior high participants will be as follows: FCCLA tshirt (can be chapter or other FCCLA event), black pants, closed toe shoes, clean apron, and head covering.

Chicken Fabrication will have the weight of the chicken from 3.5-5 pounds instead of 4.5-5 pounds to reflect product availability.

Dessert Chopped participants will now be allowed to bring pantry items to aid in the creation of their dish. These items are limited to spices, extracts, oils, herbs, butter, sugar (granulated, brown, etc), flour, leavening agents. Level 2 and 3 will be allowed the use of 1 butane burner.

FCCLA Pin Design, FCCLA Writes, Ultimate Leadership Productions will now be submitted online through the Florida FCCLA website on the Competitive Events page. Do not email submissions.

Server Relay participants will be allowed to wear costumes for the event. Florida FCCLA will vote on best costume for an unofficial award.
